

#### • CNE®n = Academic Novice Educator


 "created as a means for novice nurse educators to validate knowledge of the role of the novice nurse educator"

### • CNE<sup>®</sup> = Academic Nurse Educator

- "created to establish nursing education as a specialty area of practice and create a means for faculty to demonstrate their expertise in this role"
- Framework: Benner's novice-to-expert model
